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## APPENDIX A

### NOTES ON APPENDICES B THROUGH K AND CAMPAIGN FINANCE BOARD DATA

The data included in this Report and in all the appendices include transactions reported by the 48 participating candidates<sup>1</sup> to the Campaign Finance Board in the first filing on May 1, 1989 and all subsequent filings up to and including the January 15, 1990 filing.<sup>2</sup> Over 132,000 transactions were entered in the Campaign Finance Information System database by the Board, and every effort was made to ensure data accuracy. All CFIS data presented in the Report and the appendices are as of August 1, 1990. The CFIS database is, however, subject to change as a result of ongoing audits and filings which may be received from candidates who are still raising money to repay 1989 election debts. The notes below describe how the Board's data are presented in the appendices and throughout the Report. Appendices C, D, E, F, H, and I include all contributions and expenditures on the Board's database. The amounts presented in these appendices may therefore vary from some analyses of data in the Report, which include only relevant portions of the data, such as for the 1989 election cycle.

1. **Appendix B.** Appendix B presents the political parties, vote totals, and the percent of total votes for candidates in the 1989 municipal elections for the covered offices, based on the 1989 Annual Report of the City Board of Elections.

2. **Appendix C.** Appendix C sets forth total dollar amounts of itemized contributions, unitemized contributions, refunds, and other receipts, as reported by each candidate, contained in the CFIS database. "Itemized contributions" consist of monetary and in-kind contributions from individuals and organizations for which contributors' names are reported. "Unitemized contributions" are contributions under \$10 which candidates may report as an aggregate total rather than by each contributor. "Refunds" are contributions returned by the candidate to contributors. Refunds are subtracted from the sum of itemized and unitemized contributions to obtain "total contributions" for each candidate. "Other receipts" consist of any campaign income other than monetary or in-kind contributions, such as interest on bank deposits, dividends, refunds from expenditures, or income from the sale of goods owned by a candidate's committee. Other receipts are added to total contributions to obtain "total" campaign receipts.

For some candidates, reported contributions may include funds leftover from previous elections. These candidates attributed surplus funds to contributors in those previous elections. Goldin's total itemized contributions, for instance, include contributions that were raised and spent prior to his 1985 election.

3. **Appendix D.** Appendix D presents the total itemized contributions reported by candidates to the Board for each election period, designated by election codes. The code "89PR" denotes contributions reported by candidates for the 1989 primary election; "89GE" denotes contributions reported for the 1989 general election; "89RO" denotes contributions reported for a possible runoff election; and "SEGR" denotes contributions reported as

segregated which could not be used by the candidates for the 1989 elections. Contributions reported by some candidates for the general election and for a runoff appear in Appendix D and in the Report even though these candidates were not in the general election and no runoff election occurred in 1989.

Some candidates who had leftover contributions from the primary election carried these contributions over for use in the general election and were required to report this to the Board in a "carry over" report. The totals in Appendix D and information in the Report reflect the "carry over" information reported to the Board. As a result, contributions reported by candidates initially as received for the primary election may in some instances be attributed to the general election.

In addition, when candidates reported contributions for the primary but ultimately did not appear on the primary ballot or claim that they spent money on an anticipated primary, the Board interpreted these reports in accordance with the Board rule that contributions are presumed to be accepted for the next election. In these instances contributions initially reported by the candidate as accepted for the primary were attributed to the general election.

Goldin's segregated contributions include contributions that were raised and spent prior to his 1985 election.

**4. Appendices E and F.** Appendix E displays the total dollar amount of all itemized contributions reported by each candidate, the corresponding percentage of the total dollar amount, and the total number of different individual or organizational contributors to each candidate.

Appendix F presents a distribution of the total dollar amount of contributions reported by each candidate and number of contributors. The intervals show contributions less than or equal to \$100, contributions greater than \$100 but less than \$1,000, and contributions of \$1,000 or more.

As described in Chapter 6, the Board developed computer programs to aggregate multiple contributions from the same individual or organization that were reported as separate transactions ("contribution transactions") and to obtain the total aggregate contributions made by that individual or organization (total contribution amounts or "contributor amounts"). For example, if an individual gave separate donations of \$50, \$50, and \$100 to one mayoral candidate, his total "contributor amount" would be \$200, and he would be counted as a single contributor. The "Total #" columns in Appendices E and F refer to the estimated total numbers of contributors identified in this way.

**5. Appendix G.** Appendix G contains the date, amount, and status of loans reported by each candidate to the Board.

**6. Appendix H.** Appendix H sets forth the total expenditures reported by each candidate broken down by election code. The code "0087" denotes expenditures reported

by a candidate made in 1987 or earlier; "1988" denotes expenditures reported as made during the year 1988; "89PR" denotes expenditures reported as made in 1989 for the primary election; "89GE" denotes expenditures reported as made in 1989 for the general election; and "SEGR" denotes various expenditures represented to be unrelated to the candidates' covered 1989 campaigns. The total expenditures in Appendix H include expenditures covered by the Act's limits and expenditures that are exempt from the Act's limits.

Candidates were not required to report expenditures made prior to calendar year 1988. Candidates had the choice of reporting these expenditures in order to demonstrate that pre-effective date contributions were not used for the 1989 election cycle. As a result, data for expenditures prior to 1988 are not necessarily comprehensive. In addition, candidates in elections held in 1988 were not required to report expenditures made prior to the date of their 1988 elections.

7. **Appendix I.** Appendix I sets forth the total dollar amount of each candidate's exempt expenditures. Exempt expenditures consist of expenditures for compliance with the Act and election laws, officeholder expenses, the costs of petition litigation, and other expenses as described in Chapter 8.

8. **Appendix J.** Appendix J presents the gross public funds disbursed by the Board to each candidate for the primary election and for the general election; the total gross payment representing the sum of primary and general election payments; subtraction of any funds returned by each candidate to the Board (as of August 1, 1990); and the net public funds payment received by each candidate.

9. **Appendix K.** The eight determinations of the Campaign Finance Board issued in response to filed complaints are summarized in Appendix K.

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#### NOTES

<sup>1</sup> Because the Board did not receive any corrected campaign finance reports from Council candidate Theodore Perednia until July 16, 1990, his campaign finance data could not be included in this Report or the appendices.

<sup>2</sup> In the case of the Dinkins campaign, however, the Board incorporated an electronic resubmission, received in June 1990, of all disclosure reports made between May 1, 1989 and January 15, 1989. The resubmission is based on the campaign's reorganization of its books and records to establish an audit trail. The resubmission did not include segregated contributions and expenditures made prior to the effective date of the Act. This information, as originally reported by the Dinkins campaign, has been included in the data presented in this Report. The data described in this Report, however, exclude that portion of the resubmission (approximately \$800,000) stated by the Dinkins campaign to be part of its July 15, 1990 disclosure report. A portion of this total appears to represent contributions received by the Dinkins campaign in the fall of 1989 but not deposited until January 1990.

## **APPENDIX K**

### **CAMPAIGN FINANCE BOARD DETERMINATIONS OF COMPLAINTS IN THE 1989 NEW YORK CITY ELECTIONS**

#### **Mayoral Races**

Both complaints in the mayoral campaigns were filed against candidate David Dinkins. During the primary campaign, Carl F. Grillo, Executive Director of the Liberal Party, filed a complaint seeking to have all expenditures by mayoral candidate Donald Harrington and the cost of a poll paid for by the Teamsters Union charged to the Dinkins campaign. In the general election campaign, Republican mayoral candidate Rudolph Giuliani filed a complaint alleging that payments made to Robert "Sonny" Carson by the Dinkins Committee were inadequately and falsely reported.

The first complaint came in response to Harrington's Liberal Party primary election challenge to Giuliani's bid—backed by Liberal Party leaders—for the party's nomination. The complaint's premise was that the Harrington campaign was actually an attempt by Dinkins supporter Barry Feinstein, President of Local 237, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, to deprive Giuliani of the Liberal line in the general election and make it more difficult for him to challenge Dinkins. Feinstein reportedly helped lend financial support to Harrington's campaign. The complaint alleged that Feinstein was an agent for Dinkins, that the cost of a Feinstein-commissioned poll gauging Giuliani's popularity among Liberal party members should be considered a contribution to the Dinkins campaign and should be added to the Dinkins campaign's expenditures, and that all of the Harrington campaign's costs should be considered expenditures by the Dinkins campaign chargeable to his mayoral spending limit.

In its sworn responses, the Dinkins campaign maintained that although Feinstein was an enthusiastic Dinkins supporter, he acted entirely on his own. The Board found the complaint lacked specific evidence of acts by the Dinkins campaign which would establish that Feinstein acted as an agent of the campaign under New York law. Based upon the complaint, the Board could not find evidence to conclude that Harrington was not a bona fide candidate.

A complaint in the general election campaign filed by Giuliani's campaign manager questioned the reporting of expenditures made by the Committee for David Dinkins. The complaint alleged that three payments Dinkins made to the Committee to Honor Black Heroes were actually a subterfuge to pay money to Sonny Carson, a civil rights activist, and that although Dinkins had reported these payments to the Board, he had not reported their true purpose. Prior to the filing of the complaint, the Board had no reason to question the reporting of these expenditures other than to request an address for the payee, which the Dinkins committee supplied in an amended filing. The payments were not made with public funds. As reported by Dinkins, the information fully complied with the Program's reporting requirements.

## **City Council Races**

**4th Council District.** The treasurer of the Ronnie Eldridge Committee filed complaints against four of Eldridge's 4th Council District opponents in the Democratic primary, Scott Stringer, Janice Shorenstein, Jerry Goldfeder, and Ethel Sheffer.

Each of the complaints alleged, among other charges, that the candidate was under-valuing or not properly reporting the rental of office space and use of office equipment as in-kind contributions and expenditures. The complaints against Stringer, Goldfeder, and Shorenstein also alleged that the candidates were receiving assistance from local Democratic clubs which they failed to report as in-kind contributions. The Board investigated and resolved these complaints with the full cooperation of each of the candidates. All four campaigns either filed supplemental amended reports to correct certain reporting errors or otherwise sufficiently responded to the allegations against them.

**5th Council District.** A complaint filed against C. Virginia Fields in the 5th Council District race alleged that 18 contributions claimed by Fields for threshold or matching purposes were ineligible. The matching fund claims questioned in the complaint were reviewed by the Board's Auditing and Accounting Department, and it was determined that 12 of the contributions submitted by Fields, totalling \$2,600, were not eligible for matching funds.

**32nd Council District.** A complaint was filed against David Eichenthal charging that he received a campaign contribution which exceeded the Program's limits. The complaint alleged that Eichenthal received a donation from the landlord of his campaign office because he was paying substantially less rent than the space's market value.

In periodic reports filed with the Board, Eichenthal had reported several monthly expenditures for office rent. Eichenthal explained that his campaign used only part of the space the complaint alleged it occupied. A copy of the campaign's lease and an inspection of the office by a Board employee corroborated his explanation.
