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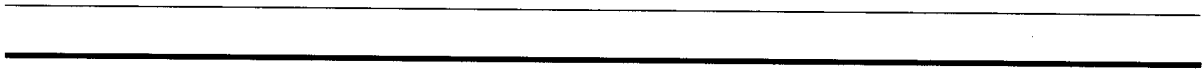

APPENDICES

NOTES TO APPENDICES AND DATA

All appendices are limited to candidates on the ballot for the 1993 citywide elections unless otherwise noted, and data do not distinguish between different committees for a given campaign. All data for participants in this Report and in all appendices are from the Board's Campaign Finance Information System ("CFIS") as of April 20, 1994, with the exception of payment information, which has been updated to include data as of July 14, 1994. The CFIS database is, however, subject to change as a result of ongoing audits and additional filings received by candidates. Figures are based upon what is reported to the Board and do not reflect conclusions about the data reached during the audit and enforcement process.

Data for non-participants are based upon financial disclosure statements submitted to the Board of Elections in the City of New York and made available to the Campaign Finance Board as of April 1, 1994. Data provided by candidates to the Board of Elections may include financial activity not attributable to their 1993 campaigns. Due to missing filings and irregularities in the reporting of financial data to the Board of Elections, the data shown may underreport the actual contribution and spending activity of non-participants in some cases. Furthermore, these data do not report loans and transfers which may substantially increase the resources available to some candidates. Vote totals for all candidates are as provided by the City Board of Elections.

Appendix A: List of Participants

Appendix A presents an alphabetical list of participants by office sought; an asterisk indicates that the participant was on the ballot in either the primary or general election; a dagger indicates incumbency.

Appendix B: Totals for Candidates Appearing on the Primary Election Ballot

This appendix includes data for both participants and non-participants through the first post-primary filing. It shows the candidate's name, participation status, total contributions, public funds payments (participants only), total expenditures, and votes received. Also noted at the district and candidate level are eligibility for bonus matching and incumbency, respectively. Specific information about the data is shown in the "notes" column. Contributions, spending, and public funds attributable to the runoff Democratic primary in the Comptroller's race are shown separately.

Notes to Appendices and Data

Data for participants. “Contributions” includes monetary and in-kind contributions; “expenditures” consists of campaign expenses paid (minus advances), including in-kind contributions and outstanding bills from a candidate’s last statement up to the first post-primary statement, less expenditure refunds. “CFB payments” contains gross payments for the primary only.

Data for non-participants. Totals shown represent cumulative contributions and spending from a candidate’s 10-day post-primary filing with the Board of Elections or, if this was unavailable, the latest preceding available statement.

Appendix C:

Cumulative Totals for Candidates Appearing on the General Election Ballot

This appendix includes data for both participants and non-participants through the January 15, 1994 periodic statement. It shows the candidate’s name, party, participation status, total contributions, public funds payments (for participants only), total expenditures, and votes received. Also noted at the district and candidate level are eligibility for bonus matching and incumbency, respectively. Specific information about the data is shown in the “notes” column.

For those candidates in a primary or subject to a primary election spending limit, *financial activity attributable to the primary election is included in these totals and is not distinguished from activity for the general election.*

Data for participants. “Gross contributions (PR/GE/RO)” (primary election/general election/runoff election) includes monetary and in-kind contributions; “expenditures (PR/GE/RO)” consists of campaign expenses paid (minus cash advances), including in-kind contributions and any outstanding bills from a candidate’s last statement, less expenditure refunds. “CFB payments (PR/GE/RO)” is cumulative, showing *all* payments for the primary, runoff and general elections.

Data for non-participants. Totals shown represent cumulative contributions and spending from a candidate’s January 15, 1994 filing with the Board of Elections or, if this was unavailable, the latest preceding available statement.

Appendix D:

Contributions and Other Receipts

“Itemized contributions” represents total itemized monetary and in-kind contributions; “unitemized contributions” represents contributions of \$99 or less that campaigns are not required to report by contributor; “refunds” represents all contributions refunded by the campaign; “total contributions” shows the sum of the preceding three columns; “other receipts” shows total income derived from sources other than contributions or loans (such as interest and proceeds from sales or leases), but does not include public funds payments; “funds from past elections” shows funds deemed by the Campaign Finance Board to have

been left over from a candidate's previous election, if any; "total" shows the sum of total contributions, other receipts, and funds from past elections, if any. (Data for participants only.)

**Appendix E:
Contributions by Type of Contributor**

This appendix shows gross itemized monetary and in-kind contributions by type of contributor: "individuals", "corporations", "employee organizations" (including unions and guilds), "political committees" (including candidates' committees, PACs, and political party committees), and "partnerships." The category of "other organizations" denotes contributions reported by campaigns that were not assigned to one of these five categories. The types of organizations are identified based on codes assigned to contributions by the campaigns themselves. (Data for participants only.)

**Appendix F:
Loans**

This appendix shows total loans made and the number of lenders to a campaign. "Total loans" represents the total dollar amount of loans received. "Aggregate amount outstanding" is equal to total loans less any repayments and loans forgiven by the lender. Advances made to a campaign are not shown. (Data for participants only.)

**Appendix G.1:
Gross Public Funds Payments**

This appendix shows gross public funds payments made during the 1993 primary, runoff, and general election periods by office and candidate. (Data for participants only. Participants who received public funds in anticipation of a primary election but were later ruled off the ballot appear in this appendix.)

**Appendix G.2:
Net Public Funds Payments**

This appendix shows net public funds payments made to candidates during the 1993 elections. "Total matching claims" represents the sum of claims for matching funds. "Gross payable" represents this sum as adjusted during the payment process (applying two-for-one matching and the office-specific per-election maximum in public funds); if the participant did not meet the threshold, the "gross payable" amount is zero. "Adjustment amount" represents amounts withheld (due to invalid claims and penalties) and amounts returned. "Net payment" represents gross payments to a candidate less any returned or withheld monies. (Data for participants only. Participants who received public funds in anticipation of a primary election but were later ruled off the ballot appear in this appendix.)

Notes to Appendices and Data

Appendix H: Total Expenditures

This appendix shows total itemized and unitemized expenditures made by each campaign during the 1993 elections, including outstanding bills and in-kind contributions, less any expenditure refunds (such as refunds of telephone or rental deposits). There are two broad categories of expenditures: “exempt” and “non-exempt.” Exempt expenditures consist of costs of complying with the Campaign Finance Program, State law, petition expenses, and certain expenditures for constituent services; these expenditures are not subject to the Program’s spending limits. Figures are based upon what is reported to the Board and do not reflect conclusions about the data reached during the audit and enforcement process; spending is shown chronologically and may not reflect an actual allocation between the primary and general elections.

Expenditures are shown in four different periods. “1990 and 1991” represents all spending prior to the 1992 calendar year; this spending is not subject to the Program’s spending limits. “1992” shows non-exempt and exempt expenditures made in the 1992 calendar year. The following columns show exempt and non-exempt spending from January 1, 1993 to September 20, 1993, and September 21, 1993 to January 11, 1994, respectively, which approximate the reporting periods for the primary and general elections. Limits applicable to 1992, the primary election, and the general election are shown at the bottom of each page. (Data for participants only.)

Appendix I: Candidates' Sources and Uses of Funds

This appendix shows receipts and disbursements for a given campaign, including in-kind contributions and spending.

“Contributions” includes monetary, unitemized, and in-kind contributions, less contribution refunds, and also shows the number of contributions made (this total equals the sum of “total contributions” and “funds from past elections” on Appendix D); “CFB payments” shows gross public funds payments to the campaign; “other receipts” shows total income derived from sources other than contributions or loans (such as interest and proceeds from sales or leases), but does not include public funds payments; “loans rec” represents total loans received; “loans pd” represents total loan repayments; “expenses” includes itemized, unitemized, and in-kind expenditures, less expenditure refunds. “Outstanding bills” includes all outstanding bills reported on candidates’ last filings. (Data for participants only.)

Analytic Data

Chapters 1 through 4 provide empirical analysis of the 1993 citywide elections using a variety of methodologies. *Data for participants*: Unless otherwise noted, contribution refunds are not deducted. For some analyses involving aggregated data, advances (payments by a campaign worker on behalf of a campaign for which he or she expects to be reimbursed) are not included in the calculation. In most cases, contributions and spending are represented by total itemized monetary and in-kind contributions and campaign expenses paid, respectively. *Data for non-participants*: Detail data for non-participants consists solely of itemized monetary contributions and campaign expenses paid. In some instances this was supplemented with summary information to obtain a more accurate picture of overall financial activity. *Regressions*: All regressions are based on the general linear model; a $|t|$ value of 2 or greater is considered significant. *Significance tests*: All significance tests are based on ANOVA supplemented by the nonparametric Wilcoxon rank sum test; all tests were conducted at the 95 percent level. *Vote spreads*: Margins are defined as the percentage difference between the percentage of votes received by the candidate of interest (winner or incumbent) and other candidates in a given race; average margins are averages of these discrete percentage margins. Percentages to the candidate of interest (winner or incumbent) represent the percentage received by that candidate in a given race.

Appendix J

Summary of Advisory Opinions and Board Determinations for the 1993 Elections

ADVISORY OPINIONS

- 1992-1 Post-Election Spending.** This opinion clarifies standards for whether unspent campaign funds may be used for expenses related to taking office and sending thank-you notes to campaign workers. It also discusses whether this spending is subject to a spending limit for a previous or future election.
- 1992-2 Affiliated Contributors.** Contributions received from two unrelated entities that subsequently merge will not be aggregated and thus not be subject to a single contribution limit under the Act, unless the entities became “affiliated” within the meaning of Board rules before the contributions were made.
- 1992-3 Special Elections.** This opinion outlines certain Program requirements for a special election, including reporting requirements and applicable expenditure limits.
- 1993-1 Contributions Raised by an “800 number” Telephone Service.** A Campaign Finance Program participant may use an “800” number telephone service to raise matchable contributions charged to credit card accounts. The advisory opinion describes procedures that must be followed to verify the contribution, obtain information required for public disclosure, and meet the requirements of matchable contributions.
- 1993-2 Debt from Previous Elections.** Contributions used to pay expenses for or debt from a previous election are not matchable in the 1993 elections. If a participating candidate’s 1993 committee also makes payments for a previous election during the 1993 election cycle, these payments will reduce the amount of public matching funds to be paid for the 1993 elections. Once the participant has received public funds for the 1993 elections, his or her 1993 committee may not make further payments for previous elections unless specifically permitted by Board rules.
- 1993-3 Spending in Anticipation of a Primary Election.** A participating candidate who demonstrates to the Board a reasonable basis for anticipating a primary election in any party for the office the candidate seeks may attribute expenditures to the primary election expenditure limit, whether or not the candidate is seeking the nomination of that party.
- 1993-4 Spending in Anticipation of a Primary Election.** All expenditures made by a participating candidate once that candidate no longer reasonably anticipates a primary election are subject to the general election expenditure limit, regardless whether the candidate’s “primary election” expenditures are less than those of his or her general election opponent.

- 1993-5** **Use of Government Resources.** The question whether government resources have been improperly used on behalf of an elected official is not answered by the Act itself. If an agency with appropriate jurisdiction determines that government resources have been improperly used, the Board will determine to what extent this improper use was to promote the election of a candidate participating in the Program, subject to the contribution and spending limits of the Act.
- 1993-6** **Advertisements Featuring Elected Officials.** If a private entity pays for advertisements featuring an elected official who is a candidate participating in the Program, the Board will consider whether the payment for the candidate's appearance was made in connection with the election. If so, the payment would be an in-kind contribution to and an expenditure by the candidate, subject to the limits of the Act.
- 1993-7** **Eligibility for "Bonus" Matching.** This opinion concludes, on the basis of the specific facts presented, that fund raising or spending on behalf of a candidate during his abandoned campaign for mayor would provide a basis for a Board determination that his participating opponents in a subsequent campaign for public advocate would be eligible to receive public funds at a two-for-one matching rate and to have their spending limit removed, as provided by law.
- 1993-8** **Over-the-Limit Contributions.** If a participating candidate receives a contribution in excess of the contribution limit, the candidate must promptly return the excess portion to the contributor. The excess portion may not be transferred to another committee, nor may the excess portion be deposited in or "transferred" to a separate account held by the same committee, except as permitted or required by Board Rules in three specific cases: (1) surplus funds from previous elections that have been attributed to contributions in excess of the contribution limits, (2) receipts accepted for an anticipated runoff election, and (3) certain post-election receipts that are deposited in an account maintained for a different election.
- 1993-9** **"Youth Respect Campaign."** This opinion describes materials and advertisements to be paid for with private resources for a "Youth Respect Campaign" to be launched by the City of New York. The Board found that the routine and not particularly prominent use of the mayor's name would not provide a sufficient basis for concluding that the private funding for this public service campaign was an in-kind contribution "in connection with" the mayor's bid for re-election.
- 1993-10** **Independent Spending by Candidates.** This opinion discusses a three-part standard for determining whether a candidate making an expenditure has thereby made an in-kind contribution to a second candidate: (1) Is the expenditure "made in connection with" the second candidate's nomination or election? (2) If so, is the expenditure "independent of" the second candidate or is it a joint expenditure? (Candidates running on a "joint ticket" have the burden of demonstrating that expenditures in connection with each other's elections are independent. In some circumstances the cooperation between candidates may be so extensive that the presumption against independence is conclusive.) (3) If it is a joint expenditure, has the second candidate paid the portion of the cost equivalent to the benefit he or she derives?

A candidate whose spending is not independent and who pays more than his or her proportionate share has made an in-kind contribution to the other candidate.

- 1993-11 Debates.** When a bona fide broadcaster makes a non-partisan judgment to stage a debate between two mayoral candidates and not to invite other mayoral candidates to appear at the debate, the costs incurred by the broadcaster in staging the debate will not be a contribution to, or expenditure by, the two candidates who were invited to appear or who appear at the debate.
- 1993-12 Attribution of Post-Election Contributions.** Contributions accepted on or after January 12, 1994, by a political committee, authorized by a candidate who subsequently joins the Program for the 1997 elections, that makes expenditures for purposes such as buying tickets for political events, making donations to community organizations, contributing to other candidates or political committees, or paying expenses related to holding public office, are subject to the Program's contribution limits for the 1997 elections, unless the candidate demonstrates otherwise.

BOARD DETERMINATIONS

- 1993-1 Giuliani and Badillo v. Dinkins and Holtzman.** A complaint was made by Rudolph Giuliani and Herman Badillo against the Dinkins and Holtzman campaigns, respectively, concerning advertisements promoting the sale of New York City municipal bonds featuring former Mayor Dinkins and former Comptroller Holtzman. The Board dismissed the complaint, finding that the advertisements were financed by the City and that any improper expenditure of government funds must be addressed in the first instance by an agency with appropriate jurisdiction.
- 1993-2 Brennan v. O'Hara.** A complaint was made by Assemblymember James Brennan against Council candidate John O'Hara claiming that no payments should be made to O'Hara's campaign as a result of outstanding issues concerning the audit of O'Hara's 1991 campaign. The complaint was resolved with penalties assessed against the O'Hara campaign for the 1991 elections that were paid by deductions from public matching funds otherwise due to his campaign for the 1993 elections. (No formal determination was issued.)
- 1993-3 Dinkins v. Giuliani (and Counterclaim of Giuliani v. Dinkins).** The Dinkins campaign asserted that compensation paid to Rudolph Giuliani and Dennison Young, Jr. by a law firm was an in-kind contribution to Giuliani's campaign. The Giuliani campaign counterclaimed that Mayor Dinkins' government salary was an in-kind contribution to the Dinkins campaign. The Board found that Giuliani's and Young's compensation was not an in-kind contribution but was a result of *bona fide* employment based upon the value of services performed for the firm. The Board dismissed the counterclaim on the ground that the Act does not restrict the expenditure of government funds for public purposes, regardless whether the expenditures may have an impact on a political campaign. The Board will not make a finding that the use of government resources is attributable to a campaign unless an agency with appropriate jurisdiction first determines that government resources have been used improperly.

- 1993-4** **Dunbar v. McCabe.** This determination involved technical reporting issues that were either dismissed or resolved through amendments to filings by the McCabe campaign.
- 1993-5** **Lasher v. Plotnick.** This determination involved technical reporting issues that were either dismissed or resolved through amendments to filings by the Plotnick campaign.
- 1993-6** **Hevesi, Holtzman, and Green v. Badillo and Alter.** The Hevesi, Holtzman, and Green campaigns lodged a complaint against the Badillo and Alter campaigns claiming that “Fusion” advertisements paid for by the Giuliani campaign that featured Giuliani, Badillo, and Alter were in-kind contributions to the Badillo and Alter campaigns. The Board found that the allocation of 100 percent of the costs to the Giuliani campaign was inappropriate, but applied the rule prospectively to future action by the Fusion ticket because this was a matter of first impression.
- 1993-8** **Giuliani v. Dinkins (New York State Democratic Committee Expenditures).** A complaint filed by the Giuliani campaign claimed that expenditures by the New York State Democratic Committee (“NYSDC”) for radio advertising and the production and mailing of brochures promoting the re-election of then-Mayor Dinkins should be regarded as a contribution to the Dinkins campaign. The Dinkins campaign contended that the campaign had no involvement in the NYSDC’s advertising campaign and that the spending was wholly independent. The Board ruled that the complaint was moot after the Dinkins campaign agreed to reimburse the NYSDC for the approximately \$220,000 it had spent, without conceding that the NYSDC’s spending was not independent.
- 1993-9** **Dinkins (1993 Primary Election Expenditures).** The Board found that exempt spending by the Dinkins campaign could not be supported by contemporaneous records. The campaign reclassified the expenditures and recalculated the total subject to the expenditure limit, conceding that it had exceeded the limit by \$160,000. In determining the amount of a penalty, the Board took into account the fact that, as the campaign had not yet undergone a comprehensive audit, the Board was accepting an unaudited figure supplied by the Dinkins campaign. The Board doubled the \$160,000 sum and withheld \$320,000 from a public funds payment otherwise due to the committee before the general election. Further action may or may not be taken against the campaign, pending completion of its final audit.
- 1993-10** **Dinkins v. Giuliani (Allocation of Joint Expenditures).** A complaint made by the Dinkins campaign claimed that spending for an advertisement by Giuliani that featured Badillo should have been charged solely to the Giuliani campaign. The Board found that allocating equal shares of the costs to the Giuliani and Badillo campaigns was reasonable and in accord with its prior decision on the allocation of campaign costs between members of the Fusion ticket.

7.28.93 Campaign Finance Board announces first public funds payments. Total amount distributed: \$1,609,381 to 23 candidates.

- 8.04.93 *The New York Times* reports on an investigation into receipt of a loan from Fleet Bank by incumbent Comptroller Elizabeth Holtzman's Senate campaign. Fleet had received contract for NYC bonds. (*The New York Times*, August 4, 1993, B1.)
- 8.13.93 The Board releases CFIS reports containing contribution and expenditure data for Dinkins, Giuliani, and Innis. Contributions are: \$5,294,201 - Dinkins, \$3,896,553 - Giuliani, and \$42,280 - Innis. Expenditures are: \$4,131,975 - Dinkins, \$2,566,133 - Giuliani, and \$87,303 Innis.
- 8.17.93 Campaign Finance Board releases reports containing contribution and spending data for 16 candidates in the 1993 elections.
- 8.19.93 Campaign Finance Board distributes \$292,476 in public funds to candidates for the primary election.
- 8.23.93 Campaign Finance Board releases computer reports containing contribution and spending data for 74 candidates in the 1993 elections.

- 9.15.93 Comptroller Elizabeth Holtzman allows the release of Department of Investigation report into her campaign loan and relationship with Fleet Bank. Report attributes "gross negligence" to Holtzman.
- 9.16.94 Campaign Finance Board distributes \$84,325 in public funds to candidates for the primary election; two comptroller candidates receive \$101,141 for runoff election.
- 9.23.94 Campaign Finance Board releases computer reports containing updated contribution and spending data for Dinkins and Giuliani.

- 10.08.93 "Nine Wall Street firms that make the most money from selling state and city bond issues around the country said yesterday that they would temporarily abstain from making contributions to public officials or candidates who could give them business." (*The New York Times*, October 8, 1993, A1.)
- 10.18.93 Securities and Exchange Commission announces a voluntary ban on political contributions on behalf of municipal bond underwriters. Seventeen underwriters sign on.
- 10.19.93 Dinkins campaign agrees to pay for the New York State Democratic Committee's advertisements made on his behalf, rendering moot a complaint filed by the Giuliani campaign.
