As a prospective candidate for the 2009 elections it is very disconcerting to consider the impact that this Legislation would cause. The contributors to my campaign are voters who voted for term limits and they are very concerned that they would be disenfranchised if I did not run in 2009. It is my opinion that it would be unfair for there to be any changes at this late stage. Candidates who have been running a campaign should not be forced to stop campaigning close shop and sell the equipment they have already purchased. How would that be handled in C-Smart? The equipment would have to be sold at a loss. If the Mayor really thought of the economy he would never have created this costly and unfair situation.
