Part 1- why this is the ultimate voting system

- A. Public accountability
- B. Hand-counted Paper ballots (Hemp paper, no trees)
- C. ADA- easier for persons with disabilities because legibly writing numbers is not needed & Ballot Marking Assistance Devices are easier to make with this ballot design (as com-
- pared with Ranked choice voting)
- D. Employs voter mobile units, electrically powered vehicles, that bring the voting to homeless shelters, assisted living facilities, nursing homes, hospitals, the handicapped, homeless voters who live on the streets and neighborhoods that have challenging access to polling places.
- E. Requires no electricity to run machines as there are no machines, just hand counted paper ballots

Part II— how ballots are marked & tallied

- A. Each candidate is marked by the voter as:
- I. Preferred
- II. Approved
- III. No Opinion
- IV. Disapproved
- on paper ballots with barcodes or QR codes for individual identification and tracking minus connection with the actual voter. This allows for a receipt plus anonymity.
- B. Tallying
- I. candidate with a negative cumulative total (all the voter's scores combined) in all the precincts and polling locations will be disqualified
- II. candidate with highest average score and highest number of votes total wins

Part III - transparency/verification

- A. Fair wages for all poll workers
- B. Separate departments for greater accountability including exit polls, poll workers, impartial introducers of candidates are to be created
- C. Ballots are to be made available to any interested public person or party for recounting
- D. at least 30 days before they are physically destroyed they must be photographed and digitally archived
