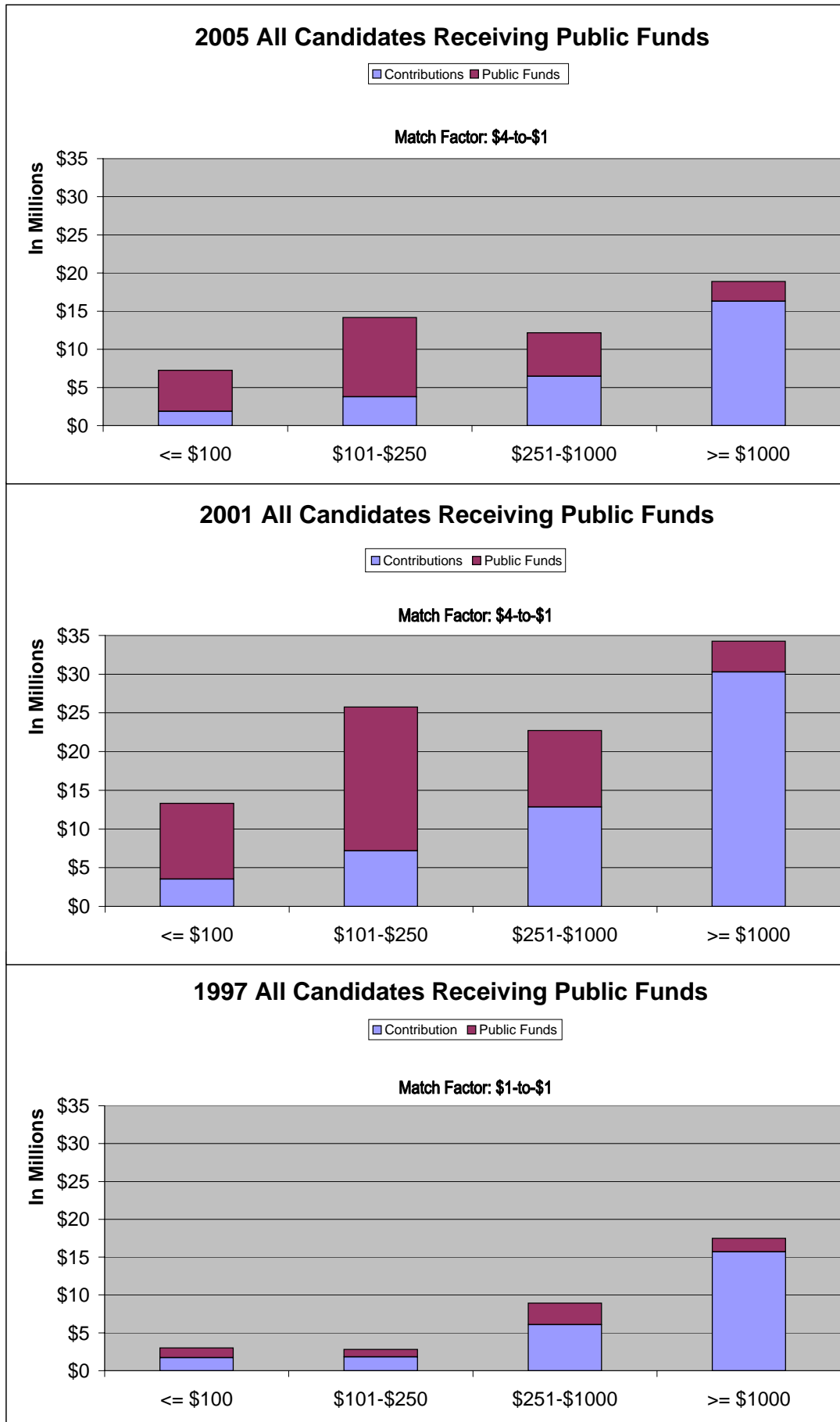

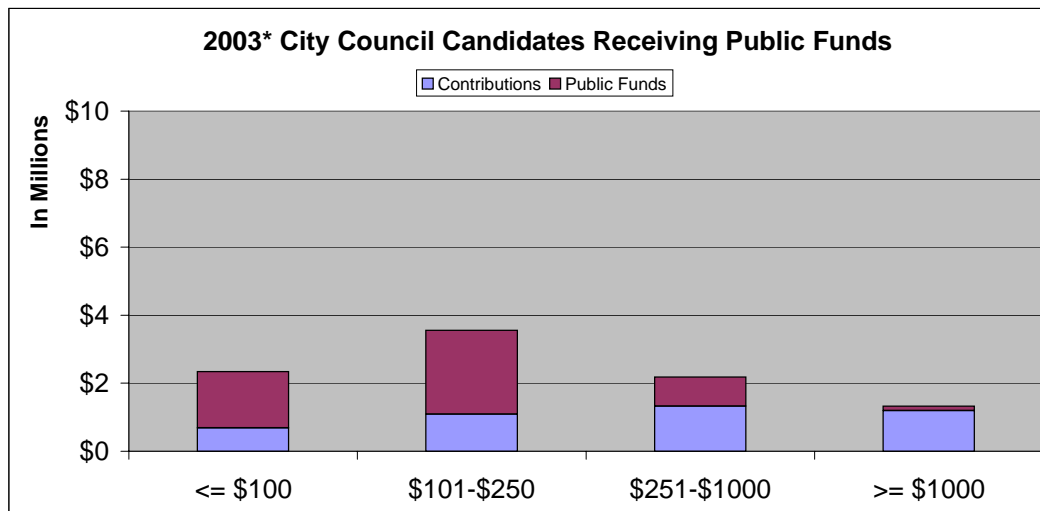
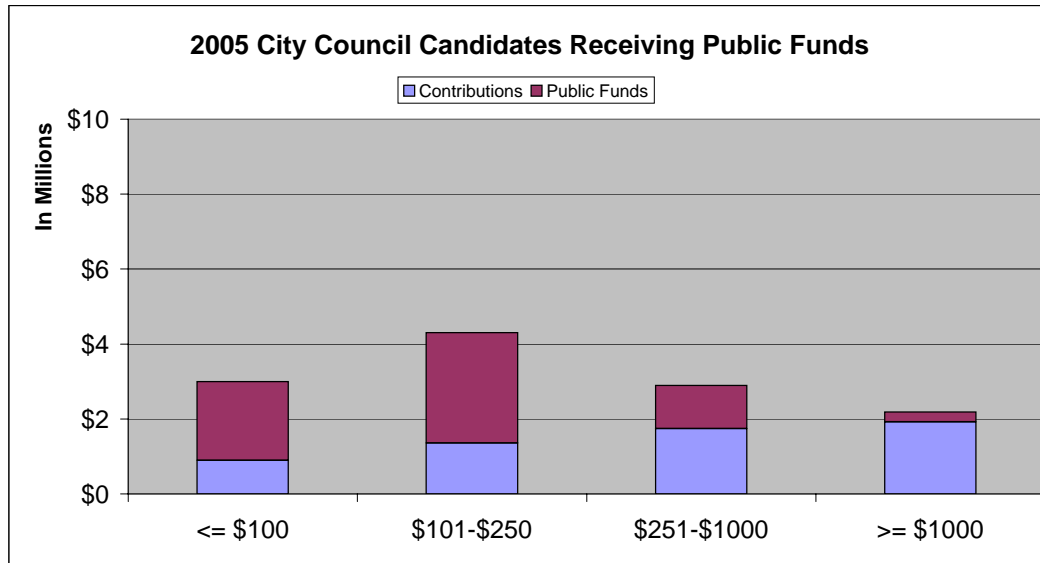
Funds by Contribution Size
